Harriet Shenkman, Poet-in-Residence of the JCC of Mid-Westchester, with Jennifer Franklin and Suzanne Cleary, two other accomplished poets, will read their work and answer questions about the creative process and how they became poets.

Shenkman earned a Ph.D. from Fordham University. She is a professor emerita at Bronx Community College, City University of New York. She holds an M.Ed. from Duke University.

Cleary teaches for the Hudson Valley Writers' Center and for the Kent Sussex Poetry Festival, based in Tunbridge Wells, England.
